

GUIDELINES FOR SILENT AUCTION AND RAFFLE 2008

1. Raffle tickets will be sold in increments of \$1.00, \$5.00, and \$20.00 depending on value of item.
2. Must be present to win.
3. Lower value items will be raffled off first, in between events.
4. Higher ticket items will be called prior to the last event.
5. Silent Auction will be held by giving each bidder a number to use on the bid sheets.
6. Silent Auction will officially open at 10am on day of the finale rodeo. Lower value items will close at 12:30pm, mid value items will close at 2:30pm and higher value items will close at 4:30pm. Staggering should alleviate wait times for our bidders.
7. The highest bidder has 7 days to claim item and pay for it. If Highest bidder defaults the next highest bidder will be notified.
8. Item goes back into inventory if not claimed. Item can be used In next years event or as a prize in the next playday.
9. Bids will start at 50% of the retail value of the item and will be Increased in \$2.00 increments, except on high ticket items which will be increased in \$5.00 increments

This is in response to your request of February 13, 2007, regarding your organization's tax-exempt status.



Dear Applicant:

Based on information supplied, and assuming your operations will be as stated in your application for recognition of exemption, we have determined you are exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

We have further determined that you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code, because you are an organization described in section 509(a)(3).

If your sources of support, or your purposes, character, or method of operation change, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on your exempt status and foundation status. Also, you should inform us of all changes in your name or address.

Generally, you are not liable for social security (FICA) taxes unless you file a waiver of exemption certificate as provided in the Federal Insurance Contributions Act. If you have paid FICA taxes without filing the waiver, you should contact us. You are not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Since you are not a private foundation, you are not subject to the excise taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. However, you are not automatically exempt from other Federal excise taxes. If you have any questions about excise, employment, or other Federal taxes, please let us know.

Donors may deduct contributions to you as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use are deductible for Federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

The box checked in the heading of this letter shows whether you must file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income tax. If Yes is checked, you are required to file Form 990 only if your gross receipts each year are normally more than \$10,000. If a return is required, it must be filed by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of your annual accounting period. The law imposes a penalty of \$10 a day, up to a maximum of \$5,000, when a return is filed late, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay.
